- Less than 55 shelter beds exist statewide for minor trafficking victims in Georgia.
- In 2022, 772 minors (average age 14) in Georgia were reported as trafficking victims.
- Human trafficking is a problem in Savannah because of its high poverty rate, international port, booming tourism industry, and the crossroads of Hwy 95 and I-16.
- Chatham County ranks 4th in the state for number of sex trafficking cases of minors.

## **Our Next Steps**

Tharros Place is a residential facility for survivors of human trafficking, girls ages 12-17. When completed in 2023, the facility will be open 24/7 and staffed by trained and licensed professionals providing trauma- informed, client-centered care. Tharros means courage in Greek, and we are creating a culture of courage in all the girls we serve.
