HOME FOR SURVIVORS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Quick Facts

- Less than 55 shelter beds exist state-wide for minor trafficking victims in Georgia
- In 2021, 494 minors (average age 14) in Georgia were identified as trafficking victims
- Human trafficking is a problem in Savannah because of its high poverty rate, international port, booming tourism industry, and the crossroads of Hwy 95 and I 16
- Chatham County ranks 7th in the state for number of sex trafficking cases of minors

Our Next Steps

Tharros Place is developing a residential facility for survivors of human trafficking, girls ages 11-17. When completed in Summer 2023, the facility will be open 24/7 and staffed by trained and licensed professionals providing trauma-informed, client-centered care. Tharros means courage in Greek, and we are creating a culture of courage in all the girls we serve.
